## DAVID HUMPHREYS

David Humphreys was announced as the next director of rugby at Gloucester Rugby in June 2014.

Belfast born, he began his playing career with his home province of Ulster, before enjoying a spell in the Premiership with London Irish prior to returning to Ulster ahead of the 1998/99 season.

That season saw him play a pivotal role in the Irish province lifting the Heineken Cup, defeating Colomiers in the final at Lansdowne Road.

Capped 72 times for his country, scoring 560 points, Humphreys spent the rest of his playing career with Ulster before retiring in 2008 and taking on the role of director of rugby at Ravenhill.

A qualified solicitor, his time at Ulster saw him oversee the province establish itself as one of the true giants of the European rugby scene, regularly reaching the knock out stages of the Heineken Cup.

## **BILLY TWELVETREES**

Billy Twelvetrees joined Gloucester Rugby from the Leicester Tigers ahead of the 2012/13 season.

Originally from Sussex, Twelvetrees joined the Tigers Academy in 2007 and had a spell at Leicester Lions as well as scoring 18 tries, 16 conversions, and 13 penalties on loan for Bedford during the 2008/09 campaign.

Capped at Saxons level by England, Twelvetrees possesses an ideal mix of size and skill. He has a fine boot when kicking out of hand and is a more than capable goal kicker.

Twelvetrees quickly impressed with Gloucester and earned a call-up to England's Elite Player Squad for the 2013 Six Nations, making his debut against Scotland at Twickenham and scoring a try in the process.

A fine first season was reflected in his selection for the England tour of Argentina. He scored a try in the first test before being called up to the British & Irish Lions squad.

Twelvetrees then continued his fine form on the international stage coupled with picking up the captaincy for the Cherry and Whites, appearing in all five of England's 2014 RBS Six Nations fixtures.

He was named club captain of the Cherry and Whites ahead of the 2014/15 season and continued in that role the following term.
