GLOUCESTER v. STROUD

This match was played at Stroud in the presence of a large crowd of spectators. The City Club was poorly represented, the whole of the back division being absent, as were also five of the regular forwards, but the reserves who were requisitioned into the team played a really good game.

Stroud had perhaps slightly the best of matters, but they were not able to claim a victory, although practically opposed to the Gloucester A team. F. M. Luce and G. F. Collett filled two of the vacancies in the three-quarter line, and played a splendid game. Gloucester were further handicapped by Gardner, the full back, receiving a kick on the head, which necessitated his removal from the field.

After a hard fought game Gloucester defeated their opponents by two goals (one dropped and one penalty) and a try to a dropped goal.
