### R.A.F. DEFEATED AT KINGSHOLM

Gloucester were able to bring off their match with the Royal Air Force at Kingsholm last Saturday, though the playing pitch cut up badly after the rapid thaw. Despite the conditions a capital game resulted, Gloucester winning by 1 goal 1 try (8 points) to 1 try (3 points). Davies and James scored the tries for the City, Boughton converting one.

The game was mainly with the forwards, and two fine packs contested strenuously for the mastery. Gloucester showed improved form behind the scrum; V. Sheppard, captain of Birmingham University, shaping well at centre.

To-day Gloucester were at Bath, and England and Wales met at Twickenham.
