ANOTHER HOME DEFEAT FOR GLOUCESTER

Gloucester had to call on five reserves to replace Boughton, James, Price, J. Davies, and Comley for the return match with Newport at Kingsholm on Saturday. The handicap proved too great, and the City suffered defeat by 1 goal 1 try (8 points) to nil. Gloucester had a fair share of the play, but combination behind was lacking, and one or two good openings were lost.

After some remarkable scoring in the Calcutta Cup match between Scotland and England at Murrayfield, Scotland won by 5 goals 1 try (28 points) to 3 goals (1p) 2 tries (10 points). H. Boughton (Gloucester) was in attendance as reserve full-back.

For their final match with France, in Paris on April 6, England have recalled D. Burland (Bristol and Gloucestershire) for one of the centre positions at three-quarter.

To-day Gloucester were opposed to Leicester at Kingsholm.
