NOTES

It gives me great pleasure to welcome President Roy Phillips and the Gloucestershire Team to Redruth for the start of the 1993-94 C.I.S. Insurance County Championship.

This is the first time since October 1988 that Gloucestershire have been to Redruth where Cornwall won by 25 points to 7. In the following season Cornwall won at Cheltenham by 47 points to 22 which coincided with the first away trip for the Falmouth Marine Band!

Over the last 3 seasons the County Championship has not been the same without any of the Counties of the old South West Group playing in League 1 South, so our old friends and foes are particularly welcome today.

The match winner is likely to be one of the 2 counties in League 1 South who appear in the County Semi-Finals in January, so the match is vital to both teams.

Last weekend saw the death of Sid Grant, former Hon. Secretary of Gloucestershire (1960-67) and President (1968-70) and more recently Sid served as Hon. Treasurer of the S.W. Division and the S.W. Mutual Benefit Fund. The Cornwall R.F.U. sends its condolences to his wife and to the Gloucestershire R.F.U.

The C.R.F.U. is grateful to the new sponsors of the County Championship whose support was only announced on Tuesday of this week. We welcome the C.I.S. Insurance representatives here today. He spends his spare time fund raising at Gladys Holman Home and 2 years ago he raised £3,000 for an Electric Wheelchair for rugby supporter Chris Street.
