BE is sponsoring the world's largest youth youth rugby tournament, the International Festival of Youth Rugby, which will take place at Murrayfield, Edinburgh next April.

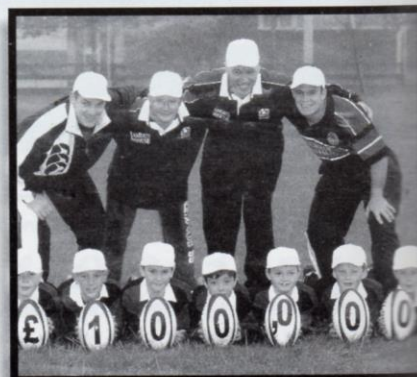
The BE finals Day, April 9, will be the climax to a four day festival which is set to attract rugby teams from all over the world with age-categories varying from under 12s to under 16s.
