

PROGRAMME NOTES

The fact that Gloucester, one of Nottingham's most attractive visitors, are today shorn of players through County Championship calls merely underlines the unbalanced state of English rugby. While some areas play their County matches mid-week, allowing clubs to field full strength sides in Saturday fixtures (which are, after all, the basic diet of the game) other areas "go County" on selected Saturdays, leaving clubs under-strength. Happily the presence of Gloucester should raise standards considerably and no one should expect to find Nottingham's delightful treasurer, Margaret Ross-Sergeant, emptying the coffers for dissatisfied customers around 4.30.

Finally, our sympathies go out to Robyn Matson, eye injury victim of the "Liverpool Gouger" last week. Despite the libelous tag of "veteran", and his formidable record of 339 First XV matches, Robyn has been playing perhaps his best rugby ever this season, and we wish him a swift return.
