15 minutes	•	Explain to the class that they are going to be researching GRFC's early years, starting in 1873, and producing a piece o

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INTRODUCTION	•	Demonstrate general internet searches eg, 'Gloucester Rugby', and then more specific searches e.g. 'Gloucester rugby tickets', 'Gloucester rugby fixtures', 'Gloucester rugby players', 'Gloucester rugby history',  Also look at how to read/analyse search results to decide if findings are relevant and applicable.  Show pupils the Gloucester Rugby Heritage website at <a href="https://www.gloucesterrugbyheritage.org.uk">www.gloucesterrugbyheritage.org.uk</a> .
	•	Focus on a couple of interesting moments in the early history e.g. Beginnings, A frozen pitch, Baa Baas at Kingsholm.
MAIN ACTIVITY	•	Issue '1.22a Research and writing about GRFC's early years'
30 minutes	•	Within a single ICT lesson, allow pupils to use the internet to search and find out about GRFC's early years and produce a Word document using the information gained. Alternatively, if using an ICT lesson and then an English lesson, allow pupils to print out information gleaned in the ICT lesson & use this to produce a piece of writing in the English lesson. Pupils can visit the Gloucester Rugby Heritage website and other relevant sites to carry out their research.
PLENARY	•	Invite pupils to share their writing aloud. The rest of the class can compare and contrast the content of the readings.
