Timing		Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION	•	Invite the class to share what they know about rugby. Ask children who know quite a lot to suggest examples of rugby
20 minutes	•	vocabulary that the rest of the class might not understand, eg, 'scrum', 'up and under', 'conversion' etc. Use '1.8a A - Z of rugby vocabulary' to aid discussion and demonstrate the weird & wonderful language of rugby

30 minutes	 Once finished, check with '1.8c Answers to the rugby word search' if required.
	• When the rugby word search has been checked, provide the class with '1.8d Making your own GRFC rugby player word
	search' and ask pupils to make their own word searches using the names of the GRFC squad. They will need to go to

PLENARY	• When pupils finish creating their own word searches, allow them to swap with partners to have a go at finding the words
	in their respective word searches.
10 minutes	• Invite pupils to say a word related to rugby or one of the player's names that they have learnt in the lesson.
