### Guidelines for the use of 'Completing the GRFC invoice for rugby equipment'

Activity title:	Completing the GRFC invoice for rugby equipment
Curriculum area:	Maths
NC objectives:	Ma2 1a), 1b), 1d), 1e), 1f), 1i), 2c), 2i), 3a), 3e), 3i), 3j), 4a) 4b) & 4c)
Main learning objective	Use methods of addition accurately to find missing numbers and then checking workings to find a grand total of money values

Timing	Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION	• Explain to pupils that they are going to be checking a shopping list for GRFC where they must complete missing items and prices, and then check and find the totals.
10 minutes	• Ask some questions about finding change from money totals e.g. if you pay £2.56 and hand over £5, how much change do you get? etc.
	Use the '2.7a Introduction to money PPT' PowerPoint if required.
	Recap on the column addition method and run through some examples on the board with the children helping.

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MAIN ACTIVITY	• Issue the '2.7b Completing the GRFC invoice for buying rugby equipment' worksheet and ask pupils to complete this. They
40 minutes	must use column addition to find the missing totals and refer to the price list where applicable.
	• Remind pupils of the rules for column addition, eg, start with units and don't forget to add the carried digit when
	applicable etc.
PLENARY	• Go through the answers to the worksheet, using '2.7c Answers to completing the GRFC invoice for buying rugby equipment'
10 minutes	if required.
	For any incorrect workings, highlight the mistake made in the working.

#### Suggested extension activities or cross curricular links:

- Calculate the food and drink costs for a day at the rugby for a GRFC match
- Calculate the cost of a set of tickets for different parts of the stadium Answer the real life money word problems about rugby equipment
