e are pleased to receive Gloucester, one of our traditional rivals, who will no doubt be seeking revenge following our Tetley's Bitter Cup success last month at Kingsholm.

By the time England had beaten Argentina at Twickenham last Saturday, Leicester had already pulled off the best result of the weekend snatching a late victory against Harlequins. We never really lost faith in the team, but half-way through the second half we were trying to remember when it was that Leicester last failed to score a point in any match. Almost imperceptibly, although following substitutions, the 13-0 deficit turned into a 16-13 victory in the nick of time. At the end of the season the four points gained at The Stoop on Friday night will be invaluable. The England team played remarkably well on Saturday not just because Argentina are a difficult side to beat, but because the driving rain made catching and passing more difficult than the counting of votes in Florida! The players had also been under severe emotional stress throughout the week due to their disagreement with the Rugby Football Union in relation to their international contracts. Looking back, and with the benefit of hindsight, everybody involved may have done something slightly differently but there is no doubt that the players grievances were sincerely held and justifiable in relation to the manner in which they had been dealt with. To take such



action in front of television cameras and reporters must have been a draining experience. Very few people will ever know the full facts of what led to the action being taken but one thing was clear - the dignified manner in which Martin Johnson dealt with the situation. He carried the support of the whole of his team with him and vet was still able to search for and accept a solution that did not compromise the principles on which he had stood. There certainly seems to be similarities between the way the Rugby Union have dealt with the players and the way they have been dealing with the clubs. I think everybody was pleased that agreement was reached within 36 hours and that the game was played. I only wish that agreement between the clubs and the Union could be dealt with as swiftly.

The 2000/01 season has been a bit of a roller coaster ride with the side at last showing some form in the Premiership with victories in their last four matches, although amazingly all these games have been

Star Turn - Ian Jones



an Donald Jones is simply a talisman of All Black rugby. New Zealand's most capped lock was named as one of the five New Zealand Rugby Almanack's players of the year on three separate occasions as well as being a Most Promising Player in 1988.

He is known as "Kamo" as he attended Kamo High School in North Auckland and played for the Kamo club since the age of eight. He initially turned out for

North Auckland and progressed rapidly through the New Zealand representative ranks until his full All Black debut at the age of 23 against Scotland at Carisbrook, Dunedin in June 1990, scoring a 42nd minute try. By the end of his All Black career he had played in three World Cups and amassed 79 caps as well as becoming only the 9th player to appear in a century of first-class matches in an All Black shirt. Following the 1999 World Cup he decided that a new challenge was in order and he joined Gloucester with his debut coming against Biarritz or

20 November. He has consistently turned in top-clas performances, week in, week out, and was voted the Allied Dunbar Premiership Supporters' Player of the Year in May 2000.
