

## Guidelines for the use of 'Design the GRFC mascot'

Main learning objective	To design a mascot for GRFC using information about the sport and designs used by other teams and sports	

Timing	Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION	• Explain that for each sporting world cup there is usually a mascot to represent the tournament, and that individual teams
10 inutes	have mascots too. Show examples at <u>http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/FIFA_World_Cup_mascot</u> ; also search for 'cricket
	world cup mascots' and 'rugby mascots' on the same site. Discuss the features of mascots and, as time allows, their
	development over the last few years for each sport.
	• Explain how mascots have features that help to identify the country or club that they represent. Ask pupils to think
	about what is special or typical about Gloucester and suggest ideas for a GRFC mascotcontinued







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INTRODUCTION	•	Look at the colours of the Gloucester rugby kit, flag and the coat of arms for more ideas. Use the information sheet '3.1a
		Kit, flag and coat of arms' if required.
MAIN ACTIVITY	٠	Provide the class with '3.1b Designing the GRFC mascot' and ask them to use information about the town, club and sport to
		design their own mascot for the Club.
40 minutes	•	Encourage the class to carry out further research and remind them about the mascot designs that were discussed at the start of the lesson.
PLENARY	•	Move around the class and invite individual pupils to show/share their designs. Other pupils should evaluate these and
10 minutes		suggest both positive points and areas for improvement.

Suggested extension activities or cross curricular links:

- Pupils make a soft toy version of the mascot that they have designed by cutting two identical fabric shapes, sewing them together, stuffing and decorating.
- Make GRFC flag bunting and display this in the classroom and corridors.
