

Rugby Scores

Try - 5 points Conversion - 2 points Penalty - 3 points Drop Goal - 3 points

Using the numbers 1 – 50, imagine that they are the scores of a particular team in a rugby match. How many of the scores could actually be achieved?

Present the information in any way you can.

Investigate different ways you can make the same score.

In all your scores, how many penalties were kicked?

How many tries were scored?

How many conversions were made?

How many drop kicks were taken?

Calculate the points score for the above.

Identify 3 facts that you noticed by doing this activity. E.g.(The number of conversions taken can never be more than the number of tries made!)
