Main learning objective:	To design a new GRFC kit

Timing	Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION 10 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss the game of rugby with the class and list major rules and aims of the game. • Discuss what makes the teams that play against each other different from each other e.g. name, colours, kit. • Explain that pupils are going to design a new rugby kit for GRFC. Discuss any ideas for the development of this, thinking about colours, previous designs, an attractive design that fans will like, etc. • Show the class '3.5a The current GRFC kit' as an example and also look at older kits and other club kits.

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<p>MAIN ACTIVITY</p> <p>40 minutes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss ideas for the development of pupils' individual kit designs, thinking about colours, previous designs, an attractive design that fans will like, etc. • Issue worksheet '3.5b Designing a new GRFC kit'. Pupils should use this to complete their designs for the kit. • Instead of drawing the design, the class could use an online kit creator (search for 'rugby kit creator'), like the one at www.rugby.kitdesigner.co.uk. They could also design other clothing for GRFC.
<p>PLENARY</p> <p>10 minutes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Invite each pupil to share their new kit designs, explaining their choice of colours, design, etc. • Display the new kit designs in the classroom and vote for the favourite.

Suggested extension activities or cross curricular links:

- Design a poster for a GRFC match or the front cover for a match programme.
- Look at the development of rugby equipment through time.
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
