



## Guidelines for the use of 'Who wants to be a GRFC history expert quiz'

<b>Activity title:</b>	Who wants to be a GRFC history expert quiz
<b>Curriculum area:</b>	History
<b>NC objectives:</b>	History: 1a, b, 2c, 3, 4a, 5a, b, c & 6
<b>Main learning objective</b>	To understand some of the history of GRFC through time

**\* This lesson is ideally used at the end of the history topic to test the pupils and recap on everything that has been covered. It is also very good for discussion and focusing on each part of the quiz.**

Timing	Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION 5 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discuss anything that the class can tell you about the history of GRFC.</li> <li>Go through the different topics that have been covered when studying GRFC and explain the main task to be carried out by the class.</li> </ul>
MAIN ACTIVITY 25 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open the PowerPoint slideshow of '5.10a Who wants to be a GRFC history expert' and begin the slideshow.</li> <li>Use the quiz as a competition between teams or use it as a whole class quiz, using discussion of each of the points to help the pupils build up an understanding of the different aspects of the history of GRFC.</li> <li>When a question is answered incorrectly, start back at the beginning to reinforce the topics covered so far.</li> </ul>
PLENARY 10 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Move around the class and ask the pupils to tell the rest of the class something that they have learnt about the history of GRFC throughout the topic or this specific lesson.</li> </ul>
