Bristol were defeated at Gloucester last September by 11 pts. to 3 and paid the penalty for wasting good opportunities in the first half.

Although engaged in time-honoured rivalry to-day, Gloucester and Bristol players will doubtless be invited to join forces in two weeks' time in the Gloucestershire team to meet Hertfordshire in the County Championship Quarter-Final. We hope their combined efforts will take Gloucestershire into the Semi-Final and that the County will go on to win the Championship. Gloucestershire last won the title in 1937 and it is time the honour came to the West again.
