Applications can be accepted from **members** of the Club only, and none can be accepted after the above date; cheques should be made payable to the "Cheltenham Rugby Football Club."

Every effort will be made to obtain the tickets required by applicants, but it is stressed that there is no guarantee that sufficient tickets will be supplied by the Rugby Football Union, who have asked ALL applicants to state in their applications **WHETHER FIELD TICKETS WILL BE ACCEPTABLE IN LIEU OF ANY TICKETS WHICH CANNOT BE SUPPLIED**. Should insufficient tickets be received, these will be allocated as fairly as possible by the Club, and a refund made when necessary. When received, the tickets will be forwarded to members. Members are warned that they are held responsible that their tickets do not get into the hands of speculators.
