#### OUR VISITORS

We extend a very warm welcome to Gloucester. They are a very old club, having been established in 1873, and have proved themselves one of the most outstanding clubs in the country and, of course, one of the most prominent in West Country rugby.

The side to-day will be captained by J. M. Jenkin, a County cap, and other County players in the side are A. Holder, M. Booth, J. Herbert, C. Thomas, B. J. Lane, B. J. Green and D. Ibbotson.

Their record to date is won 17, drawn 2, lost 13, with 271 points against 257. They have beaten some of the best sides in the country and their away victories over Coventry, Leicester, Northampton, Bath and Bedford indicate that they must possess a very good XV. Their back division consists of young and keen players, but the strength of the side is probably forward and may be recognised as one of the best in the country with a particularly lively back row.

This will be a hard game for the hospital preparatory to the cup-final clash and the result will be watched closely in assessing our chances against St. Thomas's.
