Activity title:	Design some Maori artwork tattoos
Curriculum area:	KS 3 Art and Design
NC objectives:	1.3a 1.3b 2.1 2.2 4a 4f
Main learning objective	To use different cultures' influences in their art.

Timing	Lesson plan ideas, activities and resource sheets
INTRODUCTION 15 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use PowerPoint 6.2a slides 1-4. Explain the significance of the All Blacks playing Gloucester in 1905. It was not a usual sight to see a Maori in Gloucester. Access the Internet and search Google for 'the Haka' (many different versions are available from official sources or sites like YouTube - check quality and suitability beforehand). Ask students to describe how the Haka links to tribal dance - what are the similarities?
MAIN ACTIVITY 30 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the Internet to search for Maori art and tattoos. Ask the students to use the blank face outlines to create their own Maori style tattoos.
PLENARY 5 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use Question and Answer to assess learning. How do the facial tattoos make you feel? Do they resemble the feelings associated with the Haka?

Suggested extension activities or cross curricular links:

- Design a new tattoo for different body parts
- Design a tattoo incorporating the values of their own school
