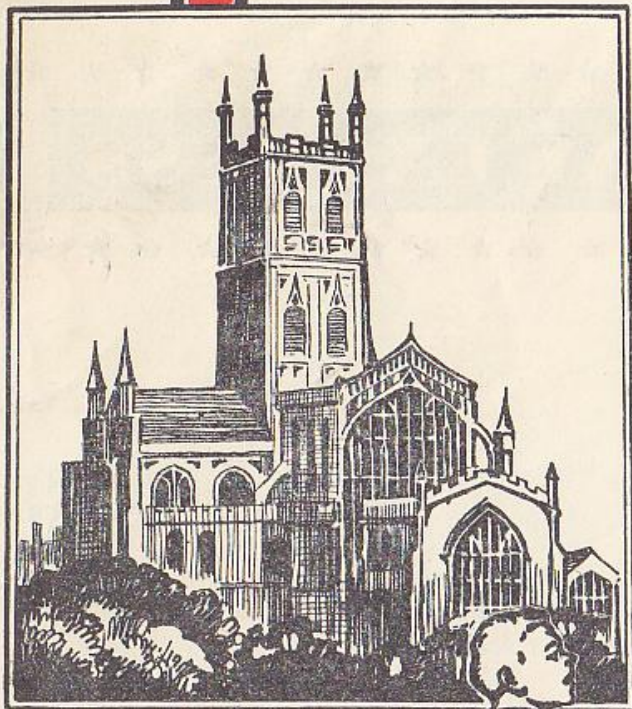

### South Western Association for the Promotion of Amateur Sport.

Gloucester R.F.C. have become members of this Association with a view to raising funds necessary towards the new club house and floodlighting of Kingsholm.
