MAIN	 Divide class into 8 groups and give each group a different player from the player profiles
ACTIVITY	pack 8.4a.
35 minutes	 Allow time for group to devise an argument for why their player is the best Gloucester Rugby Club player of all time. Hear all of the arguments.
PLENARY	 Vote on which group presented the best argument. Discuss the reasons they were the most
10 minutes	convincing.
