CLUB NOTES

Today we welcome Gloucester for a grand finale to an exciting September programme. Bristol come to this game having made a sound start to the season culminating in an outstanding performance at Swansea last Saturday. Swansea were very relieved indeed to maintain their exceptional unbeaten home record, and only did so by virtue of a disputed try and two late penalties. Prior to that narrow defeat, Bristol had beaten Northampton and Newport whilst losing away to Cardiff. The Swansea performance, in addition to confirming a continuing improvement in co-ordination, also confirmed the message of last Season; Bristol on their day (and sometimes off it!) are capable of beating any Club side in the country.

Gloucester for their part have an unbeaten record this Season having recorded good wins over Coventry, Rosslyn Park, Pontypridd and New Brighton. By way of comparison Coventry beat Newport 21—10 and drew 12—12 with Cardiff. Rosslyn Park for their part beat John Player's Cup finalists Gosforth 22—0 last Saturday. Such comparisons are a fickle guide to form however, as every punter knows!

In the equivalent matches last Season Bristol won 12—6 at Kingsholm whilst perversely losing 0—7 at the Memorial Ground. It might have been kinder to both sets of supporters if those results had been reversed, but it provided a suitable reward to the many supporters from both great Clubs who make the annual pilgrimage up and down the M5.

Gloucester are currently without Phil Blakeway, but fly half Les Jones has added a further dimension to Gloucester's game this Season providing much greater penetration in the back division. During the Summer both Steve Mills and John Fidler obtained England Caps on the Argentine tour.

Bristol makes one change from the team which played at Swansea; Clive John replaces David Sorrell who is playing for his firm in France.
