# The Match

Today's protagonists, Somerset and Gloucestershire, last met at Twickenham in March of this year in the Final of the THORN EMI County Championship. On that occasion the Somerset side, lacking several regular players through injury, was beaten by 36 points to 18. Gloucestershire cannot afford to be complacent today, however. On the last two occasions that the counties have met at Bath, Somerset has been victorious, in 1979 by 19 points to 9, and in 1981 by 21 points to 7.

In the first clashes of this season's Championship, Gloucestershire beat Kent by 16 points to 10 while Somerset lost to Yorkshire 9 - 19. Both sides, therefore have something to prove and something to play for. The contest should be enthralling.

When the final whistle blows, however, there will be a renewal of many friendships, established over the years through Rugby Football between our neighbouring counties, counties supported so well by the loyal spectators. There must be serious doubts as to whether a Divisional League or Championship, proposed from some quarters, could attract similar support.

Our friends and rivals, the County Champions, Gloucestershire, are welcome today, players, committee and supporters. We hope that they enjoy their day out at Bath. There can't be many grounds in England with such pleasant surroundings.

The Somerset County RFU is most grateful to the Bath Football Club for allowing the use of their fine facilities and for all the support they give to County Rugby. We give our thanks to the officers, committee men and ladies who have worked so hard to stage today's game.

Two weeks ago the men from Yorkshire visited Bath and have written to say how much they enjoyed the lovely city and the West Country hospitality. Today we welcome another Yorkshire man, referee David Wilson. We hope that he enjoys the game and the post match hospitality.
