The appointment of Jeff Herdman as the Swansea coach is without doubt a popular one. He served Swansea with distinction for many seasons and played for the Wales B side. We wish him every success in his new capacity. His predecessor Stan Addicott has moved on to be one of the team selectors after a very successful period as coach. The Swansea club are indebted to him for all the hard work he gave to the club over many seasons.
