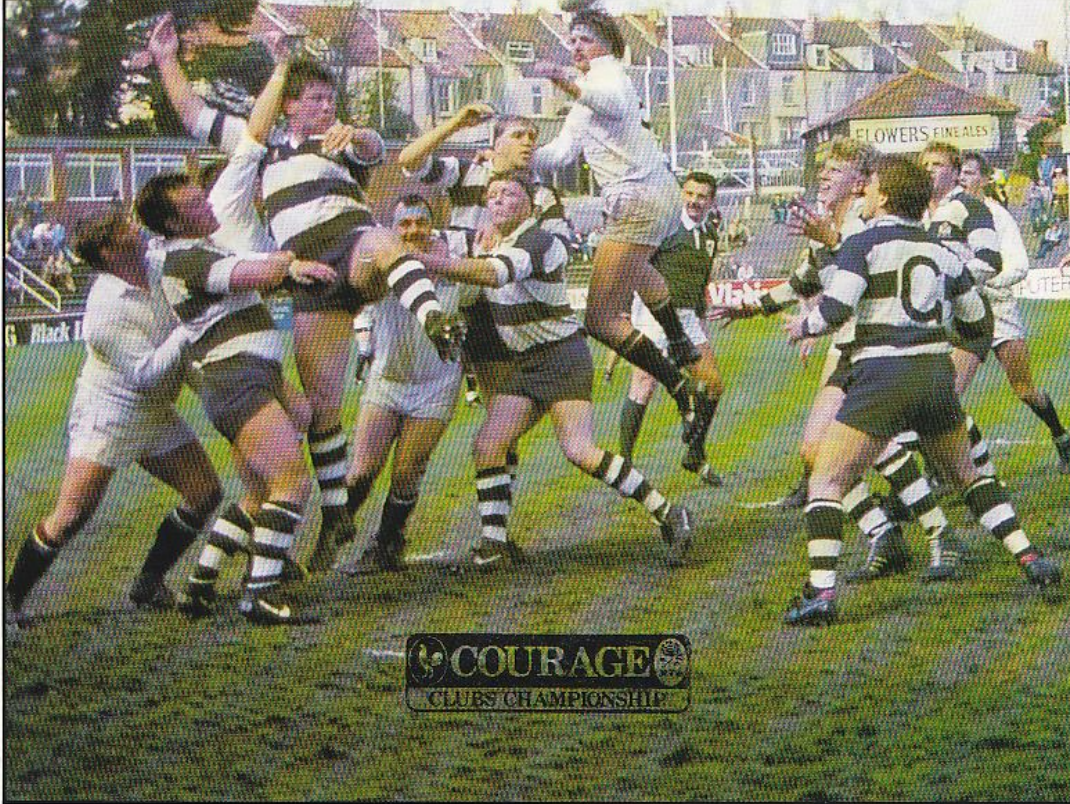

Club Notes

Today's Courage Clubs Championship match with Gloucester promises to be one of the outstanding matches of the season. It is a pleasure to welcome our old friends from the North of the County and congratulate them on an outstanding display of running Rugby in their victory by 41 points to 12 over Rosslyn Park last Saturday. They are in joint first place in the league with Bath, Quins and Wasps with eight points. Two points behind them are Leicester, Saracens and ourselves. Our defeat at the Stoop Ground last Saturday by 13 points to 7 was poor reward for a great deal of effort. Thus today's game with Gloucester and the subsequent matches, especially the home game with Wasps, must be won if we wish to win the Championship.

The Championship has been running now for two years and the two previous encounters with Gloucester have produced two curious results. In our Centenary season playing on the Memorial Ground Bristol were well on top going into the last five minutes when Gloucester scored a goal to win 21 - 16. Last season the reverse happened at Kingsholm when Jonathan Webb scored a dramatic try in the closing stages to secure an improbable victory by eleven points to ten.
