

The players below have achieved personal landmarks in recent games.

PAUL HULL — Last week at Moseley Paul played his 100th First XV game. He joined Bristol from Milton Keynes in 1987 making his debut against Newport, as a replacement for Dave Thomas. His first full game came a week later, appropriately enough against Moseley. Pauls versatility is shown in a breakdown of his 100 appearances. Centre (36 times), Wing (26), Full back (20), Fly Half (15) and Replacement (2). Paul is also a mainstay of the RAF and Combined Services sides and played for England B against Namibia in 1990. In July 1990 he went on the full England tour to Argentina appearing in 3 of the 7 matches. So far he has scored 22 tries, 23 conversions, 14 penalties and 2 drop goals for the first team, and is vice-captain of the First XV this season.



DAVID HINKINS — David made his 50th First team appearance against Bridgend. He joined the club from Moseley, making his debut along with David Hilton and Julian Horrobin in the 58—4 defeat of Metropolitan Police on 27th September 1989. His representative honours include Devon Under 13 and Under 16, English Schools (1986) and English Students (1988-91). To date David has scored 2 tries.

MARK TAINTON — Last Saturday Mark became only the 7th Bristol player to score 800 first team points, and is now only 7 points behind Jon Webb. Mark joined Bristol from Cleve and represented the colts from 81-84, captaining the England Colts in 83-84.

He made his First team debut against Hanover in September 1984 and his overall record with the club is most impressive:
