BOUGHTON SHOULD REMAIN AT FULL-BACK

HAROLD BOUGHTON'S debut in International football was an unqualified success, and January 19, 1935, will be a memorable day in the career of the Gloucester player. All the critics acclaimed Boughton as the outstanding man among the English backs, and it was a fitting climax to a fine all-round display that he kicked the penalty goal which saved England from defeat.

England's side to oppose Ireland, at Twickenham on February 9, will probably be announced next week-end. Boughton should be a certainty for the full-back position, but changes may be expected at three-quarter, half-back, and the back row of the forwards.
