FOOTBALL MATCHES IN GLOUCESTER.

On Thursday, Gloucestershire encountered Glamorgan at Kingsholm. The Welshmen, although minus several of their Internationals who had been picked to play, were infinitely superior to the home county, who was represented by no fewer than eleven City players.

The Welsh forwards played a good rushing game, especially in the second half. They scored four times, three of which were improved upon by Huzzey, while the same player scored a goal from a mark. In the end Glamorgan won a fast game by 22 points to nil. The tries were easily scored owing to faulty play on the part of Gloucestershire.
